# GreenCycle Sussex



GreenCycleSussex is a free online group with over 15,000 local members. It connects up unwanted goods with new owners thus reducing the flow of reusable stuff going to landfill and the Newhaven Incinerator. All goods are given away for free, no money is ever involved.

So if you need to get rid of some random things at work or home like furniture, books, stationary, clothes, kitchen stuff, leftover DIY materials, TV, toys, sports goods, IT equipment, or whatever don't automatically take it to the tip!!!

You simply 'offer' it to the group instead and someone that can make use of it will come and take it away and reuse the item.

If you see something offered that you'd like to have then you ask for it and if selected make arrangements to collect. Equally members can ask for things they need or want. People have received furniture, books, stationary, clothes, kitchen stuff, leftover DIY materials, TVs, toys, sports goods, and IT equipment

This is a particularly valuable resource for the economically challenged, those setting up a new home, families with young children, tradesmen, artists, students and local charities. It builds community spirit through the free redistribution of goods.
