### **London Furniture Re-use Network**

If live in London and are just setting up a new home and need affordable furniture, the London Furniture Re-use Network can help.

There are 16 furniture reuse organisations in London which have a ready supply of quality reused furniture and appliances. You will find everything you need to set up your home from the wide range of beds, wardrobes, chests of drawers,

sofas, dining tables and chairs available. Some also have new and reconditioned electrical appliances

such as washing machines, cookers and fridges, all at low-cost.

All furniture meets fire safety requirements and appliances are tested and supplied with a guarantee. Prices range from £5 - £80 for furniture and appliances start at £50.

### **Who can get help?**

Most furniture projects only deal with those on benefit or tax credit who have been referred to them.

### **Grants**

Depending on your circumstances, you may be able to apply to charities to get small grants towards the cost of the item(s) that you need. You may also be able to apply to the Social Fund if you are eligible.
